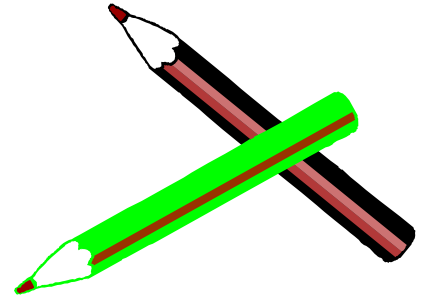
HOW DID THE CONTEST GET STARTED??

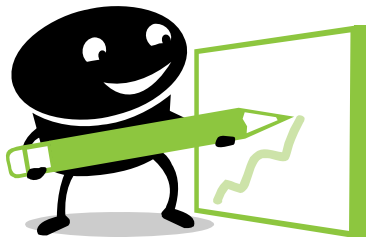
2 Age Categories:

All entries must appropriately communicate the contest theme:

Damage...Stop
Impaired
Driving!**

Each Poster/Writing Entry Must:

- **Not** display any personal information in the writing (name, age, school, etc) on the front.
- Have this entry form securely attached to the back of your entry (scotch tape is better than staples!)
- Be the original work of **one** entrant. Any "copied" work or "joint efforts" will not qualify.
- Clearly reflect the theme's message, but entries **do not** have to contain the words of the theme.
- Not include the use of any brand name product.
- Become the property of MADD Canada. They will not be returned.

Writing Entry:

- Should be a minimum of 25 words and a maximum of 250 words.
- May be prepared on computer, typewriter or written legibly in black ink.
- May be submitted in English or French.

Poster Size & Materials:

- No smaller than 8½" (21.59 cm) x 11" (27.94 cm) – smaller works will NOT be entered into judging.
- No larger than 11" (27.94 cm) x 17" (43.81 cm) including borders – larger works will not be entered.
- May be created with a computer, crayons, markers, paints, inks or pencil.
- Cannot be made of wood, plastic, metal, glass or other breakable material.
- Must be mailed flat, not rolled or in tubes.
- May be submitted in English or French.
